EGGpainting + STORYtelling + ARTexhibition





Show us your "Eggcellent" story and art talent.

Balinese egg painting has become a creative way of storytelling by depicting everything from traditional Balinese mythical characters to natural landscape and animal drawings to everyday life of a farmer or villagers.

As part of the BIS Fair program, students have the opportunity to create their own story, drawing and painting on this special canvas. Creating your own egg egg painting requires not just imagination but also patience and creativity.

WHO can participate? BIS Grade1-5 Students are eligible.


WHEN it's happening? Blank eggs (made from wood) will be given to 50 students 1 week before the BIS fair so students can use after school time to paint their own egg painting. The finished eggs will be shown at the school fair on April 12 and visitors can vote their favorite pieces. The most popular 12 eggs will be exhibited in a gallery in June before the summer holiday. To accompany the exhibition, 500 books about the eggs and their stories will be printed and the students who did the egg paintings will each get one book. Also, 10 books will be donated to the school Library. The rest will be sold on the internet and 100% of the sales from the books will be used to jumpstart a art charity program for village kids. After the exhibition, the egg painting will be given back to students.

HOW to join? Each student will be required to fill in a form handed out by their teacher before the school holiday.. Write your name and story or poem on the paper (100-200 words) and draw/color/paint on the egg drawing on the paper. Please submit the story/drawing paper to the teacher before April 5 and payment of 20,000Rp. The teacher will give the students that submit the form a blank wooden egg with a stand. The student can bring the egg back home and start painting on the egg according to the story/poem and the drawing submitted. Please return the finished painted egg to the teacher on April 10. The eggs will be kept and exhibited on the actual BIS fair on April 12.

This program is a collaboration between BIS PTA and Balitopia, an art and culture nonprofit organization which advocate issues such as art education, nurturing creativity in children, promotion of underepresented artists, and hosting an art residency program.
