#### Overview

Located at Tanah Wuk Valley, Sangeh Village, Badung Regency one hour drive from Sanur. Grade 6 students will explore the local community, learn about their culture, history and ancient system of irrigation in the Subak now designated as a World Heritage Site, play and learn in the river via tube and cycle in the village area.

#### Trip Goals & Outcomes :

1. Get camping experience as new experience probably the students never had before and team building lesson.
2. Explore and learn about cycling, rice field, irrigation and river
3. Learn more about Balinese cultural, interaction with local students, culinary and tradition.
4. Get experience and learn about abseiling and rappelling.

#### EOTC Schedule:

##### Day 1, September 25<sup>th</sup> 2018



Sharing circle / ice breaking - personal introductions, goal setting/general program introduction & camp rules /management campsite.

Introduction to campsite- proper use of camp equipment, pitch our tents and campsite set up.

Camp games / team building games.

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### **Balinese Kite**

Learn about traditional Balinese kite making and practice how to make a traditional kite.

## **Day 2, September 26<sup>th</sup> 2018**



### **Cycling-Subak-Local school visit**

Explore the daily life of local villagers and nearby village via pushbike.

Visit and learn about the importance of the UNESCO World Heritage Site, [The Subak](#), an ancient water irrigation system dating back to the 9<sup>th</sup> century that is crucial to the Bali's rice farming.

Clean up and maintaining The Subak water irrigation system.

Interaction with local students



### **Abseiling & Rappelling.**

This activity aims to instill a sense of confidence to all participants and increase self-awareness and confidence after successfully completing their tasks. Including learn and practice basic Hitch & Knot.

## **Day 3, September 27<sup>th</sup> 2018**



### **Tubing Experience**

Explore the Penet River via tube, and discover nature combined with team building games, river clean up and trees planting.

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### Goal setting cooking class.

This activity will lead a team able to divide tasks effectively while achieving targets/goals as planned. There will be some team tasks, such as:

- Fishing
- Planning for result obtained fish, what will be presented through the medium of painting.
- Processing of fish result in accordance with targets
