Located at Tanah Wuk Valley, Sangeh Village, Badung Regency one hour drive from Sanur. Grade 6 students will explore the local community,learn about their culture, history and ancient system of irrigation in the Subak now designated as a World Heritage Site,play and learn in the river via tube and cycle in the village area.

Visit and learn about the importance of the UNESCO World Heritage Site, <u>The Subak</u>, an ancient water irrigation system dating back to the 9th century that is crucial to the Bali's rice farming.

Clean up and maintaining The Subak water irrigation system.



Abseiling & Rappelling.

This activity aims to instill a sense of confidence to all participants and increase self-awareness and confidence after successfully completing their tasks.Including learn and practice basic Hitch & Knot.

Day 3, September 27th 2018



Tubing Experience

Explore the Penet River via tube, and discover nature combined with team building games, river clean up and trees planting.
