# **Update of BIS Covid Procedures - March 28, 2022**

## **Calculating Isolation (Confirmed Positive Case)**

Day 0 is your first day of symptoms or a positive viral test. Day 1 is the first full day after your symptoms developed or your test specimen was collected. If you have COVID-19 or have symptoms, isolate for at least 7 days.

#### **Close contacts**
