Bali Island School supports Education Outside The Classroom (EOTC) as providing significant benefits for young people. In the interest of the holistic development of each student, Bali Island School has established a valuable EOTC program, beginning in Gr 4 in the PYP and extending through the MYP and DP. The program will take place Tuesday 6th - Friday 9th September with Gr 4 participating 8th-9th and Gr 5 on the 7, 8th-9th. All grades will depart from school at 8am of their first day of the trip and pick up time will be 2:45pm on Friday the 9th. Students will develop the various attributes of the IB learner profile, initiate a service project and be guided towards adulthood by developing key life skills. As such, it is expected that all students attend as part of the school curriculum.
