## EOTC BEHAVIOR STANDARDS AGREEMENT

EOTC (Education Outside The Classroom) encompasses field trips, camps and other activities conducted outside of the school grounds to complement the curriculum at BIS. As outlined in the Parent Student Handbook, although EOTC activities are taken outside of school, participants are still expected to follow the BIS Community Rights and Expectations. This is especially important when participants are recognized as being associated with Bali International School.

The BIS behaviour code consists of four expectations.

- 1. Respect for themselves
- 2. Respect for others
- 3. Respect for their own and others' property
- 4. Responsible for work and behaviour

All rules and regulations are logical extensions of these four basic expectations, with some specific examples being –

- 1. The use, sale, or possession of any type of alcohol or drugs is prohibited
- 2. Smoking or the possession of tobacco is prohibited.
- 3. Students will follow the teacher's or other adult supervisor's instructions.
- 4. Theft, fighting, harassment, teasing, or threatening behaviours toward others is unacceptable.
- 5. Inappropriate display of affection is unacceptable.

By signing this form, the student acknowledges *their* responsibility to follow the BIS rules and guidelines during events in which they represent Bali International School. Steps will be taken for any students not complying with the BIS behaviour standards. For major breaches, students will be immediately taken away from the EOTC setting and sent home at the first opportunity to later be disciplined by the Administration and the Board of Directors. All costs incurred in the student's removal will be borne by that student's family. BIS will not provide any refund or reimbursement.
