The Internet and social media have transformed our world and the need to educate our children about how to navigate this landscape safely is more important than ever. The quote below encapsulates this well:

“The internet is the Wild West of modern times, expansive, unpredictable, thrilling, full of adventure and danger. Dropping our tweens or teens off in this strange land with a fervent prayer that they’ll be OK and some wishy-washy advice (Be careful! Make good choices! Don’t trust strangers!) isn’t enough.
