Parent WhatsApp Groups



We use two main types of WhatsApp groups for communication amongst parents. These groups are coordinated and managed by the PTA.

1. Class WhatsApp group (for example: BIS Grade 6 23/24 Parents (Class of 2030))

This group is for discussion specific to the class and communication from the teacher, as well as socialising with other parents in the class.

Each class has a parent representative who will liaise with the class teacher and/or PTA regarding messages or questions that class parents may have.

2. Primary and Secondary Community Announcement Groups

These Announcement groups are where time-sensitive posts and reminders from the school and PTA are broadcast. All of the Primary and Secondary parent contacts are automatically added to the relevant Community Announcement group once they are in the Class Group.

These are broadcast-only groups so there is no ability to reply to announcements. If you have a question regarding an announcement please ask in your class group.

Though you are of course welcome to leave the WhatsApp groups at any time, it is recommended that at least one contact from each family remain in order to avoid missing out on important information and reminders. This is especially important for the Announcement groups.

Grade 6/7 Drama:

Grade 6/7 drama students have been studying ancient theatre and masked theatre traditions. The class is currently in the final rehearsal stages for a production of Hercules which will be shared at the arts sharing event in November. They have also begun research presentations and performance exploration on masked theatre traditions from different cultures. Some traditions that the students are inquiring into include: Japanese Noh theatre, Chinese Peking opera, Korean Talchum mask dance and Balinese Topeng dance. The class recently exhibited the learner profile attribute of being risk-takers when they performed their ancient Greek choral poem at the whole school assembly.



Grade 10 Music

The grade 10 Music class is currently exploring Disney Musicals. Students have been collaborating through rehearsals and creative discussions aimed towards producing a mini-concert for the younger primary years in the coming weeks. We have been focussing on stepping outside our comfort zones and building confidence. For some students this has been in the form of learning a second instrument or stepping up to sing. The concert will consist of repertoire chosen by the students with pieces drawn from Disney classics such as Moana, The Little Mermaid, Aladdin and The Greatest Showman. There will also be the potential of these songs featuring in public performances at the end of semester that we can all look forward to enjoying.

Grade 8/9 Visual Arts



In the Grade 8/9 visual arts class, students have the opportunity to explore their artistic abilities while simultaneously embodying the learner profiles that are integral to their growth and development. As visual artists, these students demonstrate a range of learner profiles that contribute to their artistic journey. Through their inquisitiveness, knowledge-seeking, critical thinking, effective communication, and willingness to take risks, these emerging artists demonstrate the qualities necessary to thrive in the visual arts and beyond.





Winning Lomba Cerdas Cermat and Membaca Nyaring Competition in Indonesian

On the last day of the Term 1 Break, three of our secondary school students supervised by Ibu Sri, and a primary student supervised by Ibu Martina had the opportunity to represent BIS in competitions of the Festival Cakap Berbahasa held by Language Center of Bali (Balai Bahasa Provinsi Bali).

It was a wonderful and insightful experience for the students to practice and demonstrate exuberantly their Indonesian competencies to the public. As a result, Seo-Yeon from G9 Indonesian B class and Jihoon Choi from G5 Indonesian B became the runner-ups for the Cerdas Cermat and Membaca Nyaring competitions, respectively.



This would not have been possible without the motivation, commitment, perseverance, and excitement in learning and improving their Indonesian. Thank you to all who were keen on participating in this event, and we would like to see more multilinguists show their confidence and passion for the Indonesian language in such events in the future.
